We are a private not-for-profit agency providing services and supports for children and adults with differing abilities throughout New Haven, Middlesex, Hartford, and New London Counties, and beyond. We are qualified by DDS to provide Employment Services, Transitional Services, Day Support Services, Individual and Family Supports, In-Home Supports, and Medical/Clinical Coordination services.

Through our Employment Services Program, we support individuals in pursuing meaningful employment opportunities in retail, service, manufacturing, and other industries throughout our communities. Individuals may work independently with periodic support or receive ongoing guidance and training from a dedicated job coach. Our Employment Specialists provide job-seeking assistance, workplace skill development, on-the-job training, travel training, and continued support and advocacy for individuals, families, caregivers, and employers.

Our Transitional Services Program helps students, families, schools, and older adults explore their career interests and enhance their career development skills needed for future employment. Through a combination of community-based assessment sites, an online interactive training curriculum, internships, and real-world experiences, individuals gain confidence, develop workplace skills, and prepare for meaningful career paths.

For individuals who choose not to pursue competitive employment or require additional supports, Lumibility's Day Support Option (DSO) Programs in Wallingford and Westbrook offer engaging, person-centered experiences tailored to individual interests, goals, and needs. Individuals build life skills, enjoy leisure activities, develop social connections, explore educational, cultural, and volunteer opportunities, and engage in activities that promote personal growth and independence.

Our Community Supports Program provides individualized, one-on-one services designed to help people build independence, strengthen connections, and actively participate in their communities. Whether through recreational activities, volunteer opportunities, skill-building experiences, or community events, we make sure that every individual we support has the confidence and tools to live meaningful, connected lives.

In addition to its Adult Services Programs, Lumibility's Kidsteps Birth to Three Early Intervention Program is a state-approved program serving infants, toddlers, and their families across 51 towns in Connecticut.
